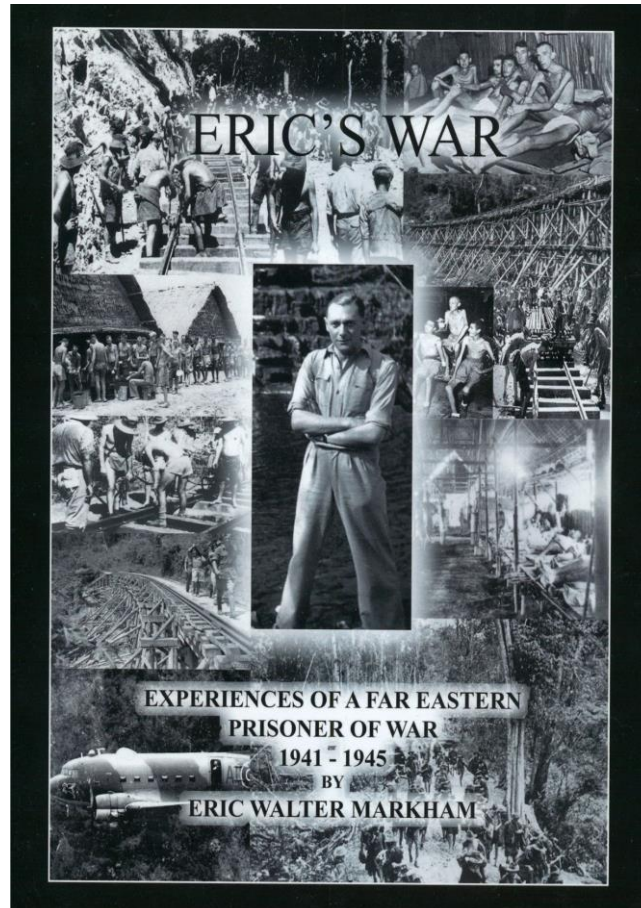


Eric's War

Eric Walter Markham was born in Darlington in 1919. His father Walter had inherited the family grocery and wine merchants shop located at Bakehouse Hill in Darlington Market Place.

This account was written by Eric shortly after his return to civilian life, following a period of illness associated with the privations suffered as a Prisoner of War, but it was only printed in a basic form as a personal record and for his family, until this edition of 2015 the 70th Anniversary of VJ Day.

The book has illustrations by Ronald Searle among others and there are many photographs. The personal style of the writing truly brings home the horrors of life for a prisoner of war and the brutality of war itself.
